
TCS Car Wash Fundraiser:



Our Christian Faith

FAITH opens our eyes to realities unseen.

Saint Joseph offers one of the Church's clearest examples of lived faith. Through Scripture records, not his words, his actions speak profoundly. When God revealed His will through dreams, Joseph obeyed without hesitation, taking Mary his wife into his home (Matthew 1:20). He protected the Christ Child by fleeing to Egypt and served his family faithfully and humbly. Joseph trusted God even when he could not see the outcome.

Faith enables us to see Christ in the poor, to trust His mercy in suffering and to believe in His Eucharistic presence. Faith enlightens reason -- not by destroying it, but by giving it new light. As Bishop Fulton Sheen wrote, like the sun revealing what was hidden in darkness. By faith we recognize not only bread on the altar, but the living Christ who feeds our souls.

Ash Wednesday (February 18th) begins the season of Lent. Regulations for Catholics are as follows:

1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.
2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

This Lent, spend some quiet time with the Lord reading daily **meditations on the Passion** according to Mark. Pick up a copy of "The Little Black Book" at the back of the St. Bernard - St. Hedwig church.

From the desk of the DRE:

Dear SBSH CCD Parents,
 Wednesday, February 18th, is **Ash Wednesday** and the beginning of the holy season of **Lent**. A few reminders:

No meat. All Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from eating meat (other than fish/seafood) on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

Fasting. All Catholics aged 18-59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, limiting themselves to only one (meatless) meal, and two smaller snacks, if needed, which together do not amount to another full meal.

Masses. Ash Wednesday Masses will be offered at the following times. **All are welcome** at **any** of these Masses!

- 8:15am at the TCS chapel (school Mass)
- 3:45pm at the TCS chapel (CCD Mass)
- 6:00pm at Holy Rosary in Owen

Notes:
All CCD students are expected to attend an Ash Wednesday Mass, per the following guidelines:

Grades 1-8: If your child/children are in grades 1-8, we will expect him/her/them at the 3:45pm Mass at school chapel. We will dismiss at 5:00pm, as normal.

Grades 9 & 10: If your child/children are in grades 9 or 10, we will **not have regular evening CCD**, to allow our high school students to attend the 6:00pm Mass in Owen. If they (and you!) would rather come to the 8:15am or 3:45pm Mass at the TCS chapel instead, that is fine!

Giving Something Up. Lent is traditionally a time in which Catholics give something up and/or take up a new spiritual practice to up your spiritual game. One option to consider one of the following "phone fast" options:

- Put down your phone at 6:00pm every day, using it only for calls and texts after that
- Remove all social media apps from your phone for the duration of Lent
- Switch your phone to "grayscale" mode for Lent, to take all of the color out of your phone
- Choose one day each week that is "phone-free"

I hope this Lent brings you closer to God and helps you grow in love for Him and for others!
