The Holiest Week of the Year

Palm Sunday

We commemorate Jesus' triumphant entrance into Jerusalem with blessed palm branches and listening to the Passion of the Lord where we hear how He freely embraced the cross for the salvation of each one of us.

Preparation Days (Monday through Wednesday)

The first few days of Holy Week is the time to prepare our hearts for the saving events of the Paschal Mystery, Jesus' suffering, His death and His resurrection.

A Chrism Mass is celebrated at each Diocese on Tuesday where the holy oils used in our Church's Sacraments are blessed and consecrated. Also, priests of the Diocese renew their priestly promises at the Chrism Mass.

Holy Thursday - The Lord's Supper

We recall that Jesus washed the Apostles' feet at The Last Supper as a sign of His love and call to service.

We were given two gifts:

- The Holy Eucharist - His true Body and Blood
- Priesthood - Men ordained to act in person of Christ and give us Eucharist

Good Friday - The Passion of the Lord

To commemorate the death of Jesus on the cross, we hear the Gospel of the Passion, venerate the cross and receive communion. Between 12:00pm-3:00pm is a time to quietly reflect on the depth of Christ's love for us.

Holy Saturday - The Easter Vigil

The Easter Vigil is beautiful and joyful. Beginning in darkness, we celebrate with these traditions:

- Blessing of the Fire where the Paschal Candle (the symbol of the risen Christ) is lit and fills the church with light.
- Hearing the Liturgy of the Word - God's saving plan as recorded in Scripture
- Sacraments of Initiation for new members of the Church.
- Celebration of the Eucharist. Rejoicing in receiving the risen Christ in Holy communion.

Easter Sunday - Resurrection of Jesus

Easter is the celebration of Jesus Christ rising from the dead. We know Jesus lives, so new life is possible for all who believe: Hope drives out fear and love is stronger than death.

Prayer:

During Holy Week, when the most bitter sufferings of Jesus Christ are put before us by the liturgy, we are invited to come to Calvary and follow in the blood-stained footsteps of the Divine Redeemer, to carry the Cross willingly with Him, to reproduce in our hearts His spirit of expiation and atonement, and to die together with Him.

Grant us the grace to preserve faithfully the lessons He has given us in his Passion and to have a share in His resurrection. This we ask of You through our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.
