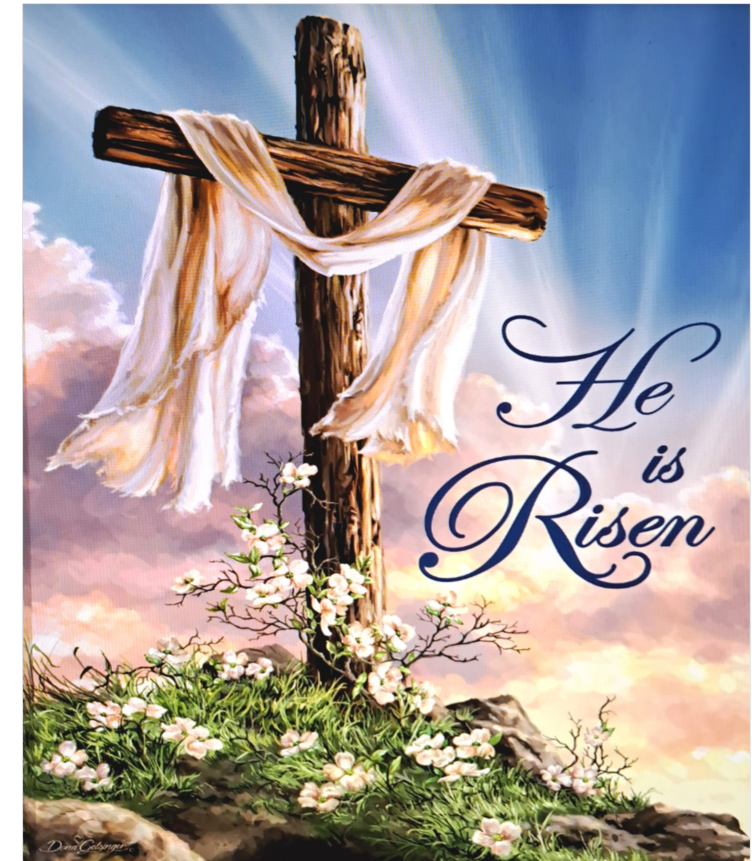

From the desk of the DRE:

ALLELUIA! CHRIST IS RISEN!

This weekend marks the highest celebration in the Church's liturgical calendar: when we celebrate the glorious Resurrection of Our Lord from the dead. In doing so, he opened Heaven, and an eternity of happiness, to all who accept his most generous gift!

Easter is so important in the Church that we celebrate it for an entire eight days—all the way from Easter Sunday through the following Sunday, known as Divine Mercy Sunday. In the readings and prayers of those days, we treat every one as if it were Easter Sunday itself!

Easter is *the* day. It is the day that informs all our worship, throughout the year. We worship on Sunday. Why? Because of Easter. We sing "alleluia" before the Gospel. Why? Because of Easter. We are people of the Resurrection!

Easter is a day of great HOPE. As Christians, the hope of the Resurrection pervades our lives, each and every day. When we know that even death has been overcome, we know that no suffering we encounter—from little annoyances of daily living to great anguish and tragedy—none of it can have the last say. It doesn't mean that pain doesn't hurt, but the promise of Resurrection inspired Saint Paul to write these matchless words, from Romans 8:

"What will separate us from the love of Christ? Will anguish, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or the sword? ...No, in all these things we conquer overwhelmingly through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor present things, nor future things, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

People of great hope are people of great joy. May all of us live in Easter hope and Easter joy, for
