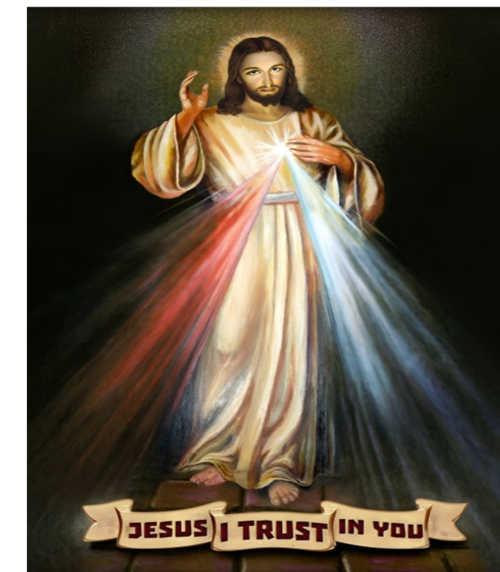

The Divine Mercy image, based on St. Faustina's vision, depicts Jesus as the source of mercy with specific symbols representing grace and salvation.

Two rays flowing from Christ's heart represent the blood and water from his side on the cross. The red rays symbolizes the blood of Christ (life of souls) and the pale rays represent the water (baptism/sacraments) that make souls righteous. Jesus showing His crucifixion **hand and feet wounds** blend the passion with His resurrection. His **raised right hand** symbolizes Jesus blessing humanity and his role as the giver of grace and mercy. His **left hand** touching his heart represents Him opening His heart to pour out grace. The **white robe** reminds us of His purity and the resurrected Christ.

The **dark background** is a reminder that Christ is the light shining in the darkness of the world. "**Jesus, I Trust in You**" signage indicates the response necessary to receive mercy.

This image is meant to be a conduit of grace, reminding us of the need for trust and acts of mercy.

This weekend, we celebrate **Divine Mercy Sunday**. Divine Mercy Sunday is a special feast in the Catholic Church instituted by Pope John Paul II in 2000.

It fulfills Jesus' request to Saint Faustina Kowalska to dedicate this day to His mercy. The celebration focuses on God's infinite compassion, offering the faithful an opportunity for complete forgiveness of sins and punishment through confession, Holy Communion, and acts of trust in His mercy. It also invites us to seek God's grace, show mercy to others, and live with deep trust in His compassion. It is a day of hope, renewal, and deep gratitude for the gift of salvation.

We will have a special benediction at the end of the 4:00pm and 8:00am Masses and a continued adoration after the 10:00am Mass until 3:00pm in St. Bernard-St. Hedwig Church. At 2:10pm we will recite the Rosary followed by the Divine Mercy Chaplet and Benediction at 3:00pm on Sunday, April 12 in the Thorp church. Confessions will be heard from 2:10pm until 2:50pm.

I encourage all and appreciate those of you who take part in this adoration and receive unconditional mercy and forgiveness from the Lord for the rest of our lives.

The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting.
