Mass of Hope and Healing: Bishop Gerard Battersby will celebrate a Mass of Hope and Healing on this Tuesday, September 23rd, at 6:30pm, Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman, 530 Main St, La Crosse. This Mass will be offered for anyone grieving the loss of children through miscarriage, stillbirth, ectopic pregnancy, abortion, accident or infant death. Book of remembrance will be available before and after Mass for those who would like to inscribe the name(s) of their child(ren). Votive candles will be given to families before Mass in remembrance of each child. Candles will be lit and carried forward by family members, just before the entrance procession, and placed before the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. After Mass, refreshments will be served along with a display of resources and books in the Gathering Space. Volunteers with name tags will be present to offer assistance, support and comfort.

### From the desk of the DRE.

I was recently having a discussion with some TCS students in the classroom about the need to place God first in life. They all seemed to agree that it made sense. But then, I started to dig deeper, especially with the older students: "The time is soon coming," I said, "when you're going to have to make decisions that either maintain keeping God first or push him out of that place."

I then offered an example: "What if you are interviewing for a job, and your potential employer states that the job will require you to work all day Saturday and Sunday? No time for Sunday Mass. What will you do then? Will you keep God as top priority in your life?" I would like to think that the positive responses I received will indeed reflect reality when the pressures and demands of young adulthood descend upon them in the coming years.

In our Gospel lesson for this Sunday, Jesus reminds us all that we can't serve both God and money. In addition, he tells us that "The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones; and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones."

The merciful truth is this: if and when God slips out of first place in your life, he always gives you another chance. How can we move toward making God first? Let's take Jesus at his word: in small matters. Stopping, as a family, to offer a prayer of thanks before eating. Making Sunday Mass a priority. Reading a few verses of Scripture daily. I am sure of this: we will <u>never</u> regret making God a priority in our lives. No one loves you more, and the more we put him first, the more of his love we receive.
