#### From the desk of the DRE.

At first read of this Sunday's Gospel lesson, Jesus' words to his apostles seem harsh. They come to him and beg of him, "Increase our faith!" He tells them that even faith the size of a mustard seed could move a tree into the sea—seemingly implying that the faith they have is miniscule.

If that weren't enough, he goes on to tell a parable with the explicit moral: "When you have done all you have been commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do." Ouch!

I think Jesus' words sting because we live in a society that values a person based on his or her <u>productivity</u>. We praise achievement. We honor those who excel. What's more, in the Catholic Church, don't we <u>canonize</u> (make saints out of) people who <u>accomplish</u> all these amazing spiritual things?

The point of it all may be better news than we initially realize: Jesus is not condemning those who desire more faith. He is not denigrating service and good deeds.

Rather, he is again pointing out that we do not earn God's grace and favor. We are "unprofitable," because with God, everything is gift.

Do the saints do amazing things? Of course. But only because they treasured this truth deep within them: our entire identity is founded on God's prior and limitless love for us, and we are mere recipients of that love. When we open ourselves to receive God's love, cooperate with that love by following God's commandments, and offer ourselves as living sacrifices to God (see Romans 12:1), we—nourished by his Body and Blood, and empowered by his Holy Spirit—become the very saints we are called to be!
