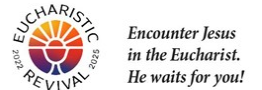

The disciples recognized the Lord Jesus in the breaking of the bread. (Luke 24:35)

Eucharistic Revival-week of April 14, 2024-Third Sunday of Easter. A Minute with Jesus: The Eucharist is the Risen Christ! On Easter, two disciples were leaving Jerusalem without hope as they believed that the Savior was dead. Jesus joined them as they walked but the disciples did not recognize Him as He now had a glorified body. The disciples were unable to interpret the events of Jesus' passion and death because they did not understand the whole Story. Jesus explained the things concerning Himself from "all the Scriptures." When Jesus was at the table with the disciples at Emmaus, they recognized Him upon receiving the Eucharist. Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Lord, make my heart burn with a desire to read Your Word in Sacred Scripture. This week, read how Jesus explained how He fulfilled the Old Testament in His passion, death and resurrection, and allowed the disciples to recognize Him in the breaking of the bread - the Eucharist - in Luke 24:13-35.
