requires Sacramental Confession before receiving Holy Communion. If you are not sure about this, speak with a priest. Let's pray this right

now and every day this nght now and every day this week: Jesus, please give me the grace to be truly sorry for my sins. This week read how God calls



us out of darkness into His own wonderful light in 1 Peter 2:9-10.
