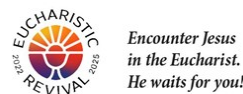

Eucharistic Revival-week of May 19, 2024-Pentecost Sunday A Minute with Jesus: The Holy Spirit and the Eucharist Even after the Apostles had experienced the Risen Christ, they were afraid. They gathered with Mary on the day of Pentecost and prayed behind locked doors, waiting as instructed for the Gift of the Holy Spirit. After the Holy Spirit descended upon them on Pentecost, the Apostles were no longer afraid and were equipped to fulfill their mission. It is the same for us today. When we receive the Eucharist, we also receive God the Holy Spirit, to abide in the depths of our hearts. If we allow Him, the Spirit of Truth will transform us and we will no longer be afraid but be equipped with peace and strength for our mission. Let us then prepare for each Eucharistic encounter in the same way the Apostles prepared for Pentecost, "in prayer ... with Mary ..." (Acts 1:14).

From the desk of the DRE

Are you Pentecostal? "No," you might answer, "I'm Catholic." But I believe that all Catholics can—and should—be "Pentecostal" in the sense that they are open to and ready to cooperate with the powerful work of the Holy Spirit in their lives!

Have another look at today's first reading, the account of the first Pentecost, from Acts 2:1-11. Note how the Holy Spirit comes in power: a sound like a driving wind and tongues of fire! And the Apostles, having received the Holy Spirit, are now able to speak in different languages. The Tower of Babel (see Genesis 11) is reversed! God is not confusing languages but drawing all of his lost children together in unity.

What I try to impress upon our Confirmation students is a concept straight from the *Catechism*: when you got Confirmed (and see me if you still need that to happen!), it was your own, personal, participation in the event of Pentecost! **You** have been filled with the Holy Spirit! **You** are empowered by him to do astonishing deeds in service to the Gospel of Jesus! **You** are a participant in the very divine life of God! ...but all this hinges on *your* yes. Your cooperation. Try it today—pray, "Holy Spirit, I believe you are living within me. I welcome you to move and act in my life. I give you my 'yes': do what you will within me and through me, all for the sake of the Gospel of Jesus" ...and just see what he does! If we all do that, we will indeed be a "Pentecostal" Catholic Church!
