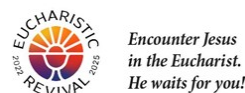

School is now officially over for the 2023-24 school year. We have been so blessed this year! 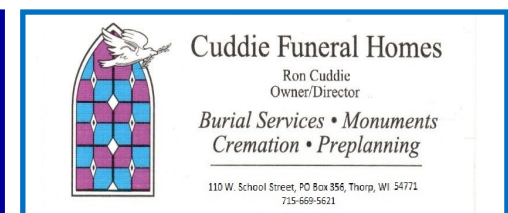
