Eucharistic Revival-week of June 23, 2024-Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time A Minute with Jesus: The word Eucharist actually means thanksgiving. The Sacrament of the Eucharist is an action of thanksgiving to God. We want to thank our Heavenly Father for His works: creating the whole world and each one of us; sending His Son to redeem us through His Death and Resurrection; healing and purifying us through the grace of the Sacraments; and giving us the gift of Eternal Life with Him. Pastor writes...

My Dear loving People,
 With heavy heart and much sorrow, I inform you that my father, **Antony of 90 years old, passed away on Tuesday June 18th** at my home peacefully surrounded by his children and family members. After my mother's death on March 7th. 2023, he was always sad thinking about my mother and weeping all the time. He could not imagine another life without my mother. He found it meaningless to live alone without her and so he used to go to the cemetery of my mother often and talk to her alone. Whenever I spoke to him over the phone, he used to tell me that my mother calls him to heaven. As he said, he has gone to be with my mother permanently leaving me alone as an orphan. I strongly believe that it is purely a God's plan that he should be with my mother safe and comfortable in heaven.
 My father's funeral went on well on Wednesday June 19th at parish Saint Mother Theresa's church in my native place. My bishop **Most Reverend Lourdu Anandam** officiated the funeral Mass and all of my diocesan and religious brother priests concelebrated and consoled my family on that funeral day.

I feel guilty of myself because as a son, I have not done anything to my mother and my father in my life and at least I was not able to be with them during the last stages of their life. Hence, I request your valuable prayers to my father and to my family members so that we might be consoled and strengthened by God. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed through the mercy of God, **REST IN PEACE.** Amen.
